- Children who have impressed us can get a certificate in special book assembly.

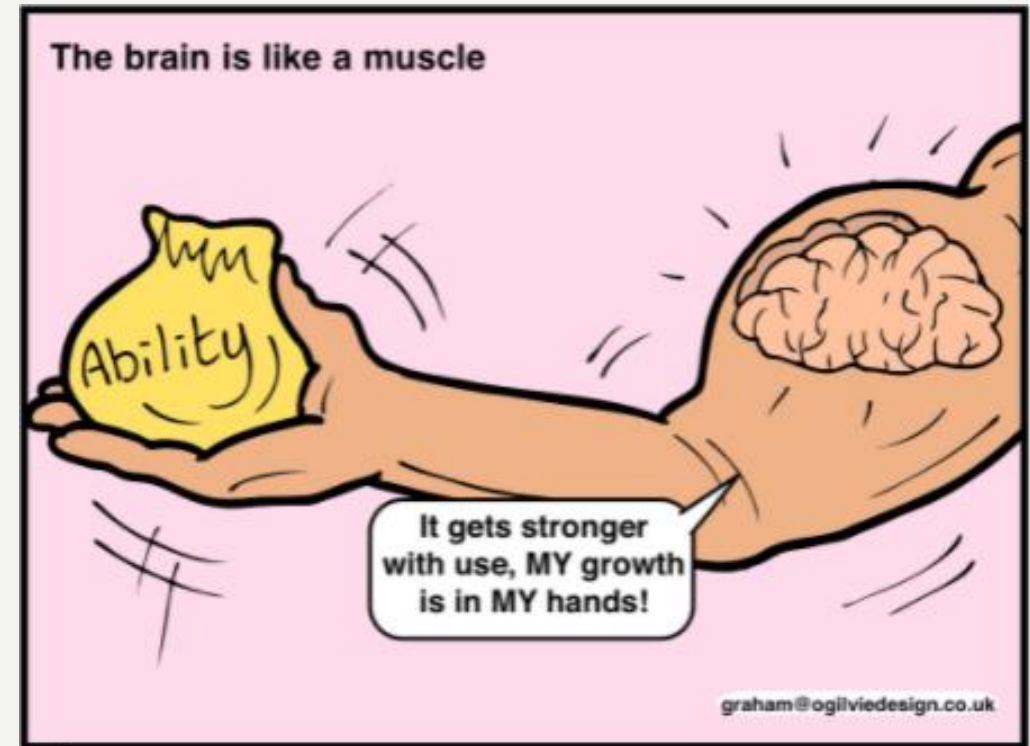
